I Richard Reynolds of the County of Jones and State of
North Carolina being in Common Health but knowing it is
appointed for all men and to die do make and ordain
this my last Will and Testament in form as followeth vizt
Item 1st I recommend my soul to Almighty God who gave it me
and my body to be buried in a Christian like manner at
the discretion of my Executors.

Item 2nd Whereas my arks here have been heretofore provided for I
give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah B Green the sum of one
dollar and also unto the heirs of my Son James one dollar each
and also to my Grand Son Edmund Hatch one dollar

Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto my Grand Son Richard I
Hatch the Plantation and lands on White oak river known by the
name of the Treasure upper plantation and also the following
Negro Simon and his wife Rachel and four Children Tom,
Marrett, Dick and Evaline. also one bed and furniture for the
same together with four Horses and four Cows and Calves
which property my Executors is to deliver to my said Grand Son
at my death.

Item 4th I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Nancy
Laroque and Negro Girl named Betty and her increase:

Item 5th I give and bequeath unto my Grand Son Richard I Green
all the lands I bought of Michael Thomas also all the lands and
plantation on which I now live together with the following Negroes
my Arnold and children Henry, Christopher, Hugh and Sylvia
Old Affy, Tom, Leah, Mary, George and Penny, Robbins Hollan and
five Children Joshua, Sarah, Moses, Aaron and Amos, also Silvana
five children Venice, Demos, Molly, Lot, and Eliza and also all of my
Note Book accounts and all of my property which I have not heretofore
written away

Item 6th and lastly I nominate and appoint and by these presents
do nominate and appoint my Grand Son Richard I Green sole
Executor to this my last will and Testament. revoking all former wills
heretofore made by me this the 21st March A.D. 1813

mind and memory be it so that the 31st day of February in the Year of our Lord 1844
make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner following that is to say
Item 1st I give unto my Brother Amos S. Koom my Negro Girl Hollum and her increase
to him his heirs and assigns forever also all he is due me
Item 2nd I give unto my Nephew Simon Everett Koom my Negro boys to wit Arthur
and Charles to him his heirs and assigns forever
Item 3rd I give unto my Brother Michael Koom one dollar to him his heirs and assigns forever
Item 4th I give unto my Sister Mary Hardy one dollar to her heirs and assigns forever
Item 5th I give unto my Sister Mary Cox one dollar to her heirs and assigns forever
Item 6th I give unto my Brother John S. Koom all my Notes Money and Accounts and
every thing that is not named above after paying all my just debts to him his heirs
and assigns forever
And I hereby do nominate and appoint my Brother John S. Koom Executor to this my
last will and Testament revoking all other former wills made by me when of sound
discreet mind and memory
by the said Simon E. Koom the
Executor as his last will and Testament
