

In the Name of God Amen

I Resden McDaniel Sen. of the County of Jones & State of N^o Carolina being in good health & of sound mind & memory but recollecting that all men have to die, do make & Ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following. That is to say —

Item — I give to my wife Mary all that part of my estate that I got with her by marriage with the said Mary —

Item — I give to my son James McDaniel all that part of my Lands and plantation laying on the West side of Crooked Run, and on the east side of the following lines (viz) Beginning in the fork branch & in Harts line & running with the Crook fence through my plantation & to a pine corner, thence to the fork pond, thence to the back line up with a dress, then round to the first beginning in Harts line — also two feather beds — bedstead & bed furniture — also my young Horse, two Cows & Yearlings, two steers — all my Hogs, two ploughs, one saw, one Saddle & one pair of Iron wedges — But should my son James die, without lawfully heirs begotten of his body then and in that case the lands above willed to him, to go to my son Resden otherwise to him his heirs and assigns for ever —

Item, I give to my son Resden McDaniel all the residue of my lands lying on both sides of Crooked Run to him his heirs & assigns for ever —

Item, I give to my grand son John McDaniel one pewter dish, —

Item I give to my grand son John Lewis McDaniel one pewter dish —

Item, I give to my grand son Lemuel McDaniel, one feather Bed and one pewter dish to him his heirs & assigns for ever —

Item, my Will & desire is that the residue of my estate of all sorts whatsoever should be sold & equally divided among my five daughters & the heirs of my son John, my grand children to take their fathers equal share —

Item, I hereby constitute and appoint my son Resden McDaniel Executor to execute this my last Will & Testament, making void all other Wills by me made — In witness whereof I set my hand & seal this 14th day of January 1832. —
