

96. Pybus is to prohibit this mother from the use of this  
land of plantation during her life or widowhood to  
him and his heirs forever. neither the mother to prohibit  
the owner of the land from the use of it in her life.

I give all the rest of my estate only such thing  
as I gave the children above named which I be-  
told her during life or widowhood at her death or marriage  
all those things that I left her to be equally divided be-  
tween my Daughter Catherina Pybus Henry Pybus William  
Pybus Nathan Pybus or otherwise if she should live a  
widow to see the children grown up to years of age so as to  
leave her the may other provision of the law sparing it  
half thone to thos that will best suit her not so as  
to disfurnish any one more than an other.

I give I leave all my Carpenter and joiner Tools to be  
left to pay my debts that is all that is justly due.

I give I constitute and appoint my son and trustee friend  
John Pybus & John Parry my sole and true Executor of this  
my last will and Testament utterly abannulling all

This was the written last will and Testament of Henry Pybus and proven in open  
Court by the oaths of John Quater one of the subscribers witnesseth North Carolina

the subscriber Justice of the Peace

In the name of God Amen I make this day of the County  
of Jones and State of North Carolina being of sound mind  
and memory as make and ordain this to be my last will and  
Testament in manner and form following To wit

First of all my soul I commend to God who gave it and my body  
I commit to the dust till the great day of the resurrection  
nothing doubting but that I shall receive the same again  
through the merits of my Rescuer and as for the worldly  
goods which it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow on  
me I give in manner and form following To wit

I give unto my beloved Son William Pybus one feather bed  
and furniture. I give also and bequeath unto my beloved  
Son Nathan Pybus all that myfayre or Fairment of land  
with the appurtenances thereunto belonging in the Town of  
Newbern wheron he now lives which I had by Land from  
John Lee to Lein the said Nathan Pybus his head and  
elgins forever — I give and bequeath to my beloved Son  
Isaac Pybus one negroe man called George to him his  
hires and elgins — I give unto my Daughter Mary Black  
all my weareing Apparell and a suit of Mourning to pur-  
chase for her by my Executor — I give unto my Grand  
Daughter Ann Pybus Daugher of son Thomas Pybande.  
one Colar ring to be purchased for her by my Executor in  
full of her said dauids father share of my estate —

I give unto my Grand son James Harry Pybus son of my  
son Harry Pybus <sup>one Nativity</sup> to be purchased for him by my  
Executor in full of his said dauids father share of my  
estate — I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Lewis  
Pybus all the rest and residue of my estate of what a man-

a kind leave to have his heirs and afflign forever —  
all my just debts being first paid out of the same.  
Lastly I do hereby appoynd my four sons William Nathan  
Anne & Lewis Bryan executors to this my last will and  
Testament desirring that they will be my executors bound  
and put this my will into execution In witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this  
fourth day of January one thousand seven hundred  
and eighty five —

manner at the discretion of my Executors & as for what  
worthly goods it has please God to bestow on me I would  
give in the manner & form following Impri'me.  
Item I bind unto my beloved wife Elizabeth for the plan-  
tation & land where I now live during her natural  
Item I give & bequeath unto my wife one negro man  
called Luke also one negro girl called Bess also one negro  
called Fatty also one negro boy called Peter also one horse called  
Maky also one mare called Tilly also one young horse —  
called Dick also six pens Horses also one geld & one  
called Buck & Duke also two year old steers also two gelds  
Bos & turnstones & two Bushlands also half dozen Chicks  
also two doz Iron bars one Slough & Fluke also three  
Pistols also two Cases of bottles also one doz Iron wedges also  
two flat Irons also two Axes also two hoes also one grub  
bing hoe also for Knaves also ten Shillings, Beale also three  
Dishes also one Tea kettle also all my reading Books  
also one doz Hand Irons also three iron potts also one hand  
Kiss also one half of all my hoggs also half of all my Cows  
also all my horses also all my pease also all my flax &  
Cotton also all my Sheats wool also bags of all my sheep  
also all the Sheep leather, spun wool and all the Spun flax  
Also also one wrodden wheel & one Linnen Wheel also one  
or Cart the above mentioned I give to her her heirs  
& affligns forever.

Item I give to my son Frederick Lee the Plantation  
& Land where I now live after my Elizabeth Lee death  
also one negro woman Bess also one negro girl
