I Sarah Lepsey of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina seriously considering the uncertainty of life, and mindful of the obligation upon every person to learn their affairs in order, do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament in words as follows, viz —

Imprimis, It is my wish that my Executors herein after named should liquidate and pay all my just debts —

Item, I give to my grand daughter Eliza Hargett one Bed, bedstead & furniture to her, her heirs and assigns for ever —

Item, I give to my grand son Abner Hargett, one Bed, bedstead & furniture to him, his heirs and assigns for ever —

Item, I give to my grandson John Barrus Ten dollars to him his heirs and assigns for ever —

Item, I give to my grandson Rose Barrus Ten dollars to him his heirs and assigns for ever —

Item, I give to my three grand children, Eliza Hargett, Abner Hargett and William Hargett all the rest & residue of the funds which may be remaining in the hands of my Executors after paying off my just debts and the above named legacies (which funds will arise by the sale of all my property not herein devised) to be equally and fairly divided among them, and to be applied to educating them —

And lastly I nominate and appoint my grand son Rose Barrus executor to this my last Will & Testament —

And finally I commit my soul & body to that Being who gave them me firmly believing that by a faithful performance on my part of those duties which he has made obligatory on me, through Christ the Saviour of the world He will give me a glorious immortality —

The above I publish as my last Will and Testament, In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this 5th day of December A.D. 1831 —
