do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament -

- First. I recommend my soul to that God who gave it my body decently buried -
Item I give and bequeath to my niece Elizabeth Stephens Williams daughter of my Brother
Thomas Williams as follows. Negro's Phias, Allender, & Milly & boy Rob & Joe, One bed
and Furniture. my wearing apparel and all my Silver. to her her heirs and assigns
for ever.
Item. I give and bequeath to my nephew, Charles Williams son of my brother Thomas Williams
my four Plantation in Craven County. to him his Heirs and assigns forever -
Item. my Will and desire that my Executor hereinafter should hire out the above property
for the support of said children untill they come of age or marry.
Item. All the residue of my property. of every description after paying my Just debts and
funeral expences I give unto my brother Thomas S. Williams to him and his Heirs and
assigns for ever.

Lastly. I nominate and appoint my Brother Thomas S. Williams my Executor to this
my last Will and Testament revoking all others heretofore by me made
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 24th day of
April in the Year of our Lord 1817.
