

Be it known that I Simon Foresee of Jones County & State of North Carolina, do make this my last Will & Testament as follows that is to say - I give all my personal property after paying my just debts to be equally divided between my wife & six youngest Children, namely, Eliza, Nancy, Polly, Hannah, John Edward & Christened, to them or such of them as shall be living at my decease, their Executors & Administrators for ever -

Item 2^d. I give to my son John Edward all my land I bought of Mr. George Pollack & that bought of Daniel Markburn and that bought of Benjamin D. Gray to him his heirs & assigns for ever -

Item 3^d. I give to my daughter Christiana the land I bought of Stephen Foresee to her her heirs and assigns for ever -

Item 4th. I give to Nancy a piece of Land on Bevidam, patented by Stephen Elghman and deeded to me, to her her heirs & assigns for ever;

Item 5th. I give to Joseph Rhinard of Craven County in trust for my daughter Julia the land I bought at Sheriff Sale that was Lewis Sandersons in trust that he pay & apply the profits to the sole & separate use of my daughter, the wife of Lewis Sanderson and without his Control during his life and after his decease to the sole use of my S^d daughter and her heirs for ever -

Lastly, I nominate and appoint my son John Edward, Executor to this my last Will &c. Reserving all former Wills by me made &c. - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 11th day of May 1830. -
