In the name of God Amen,

I Thomas Barrett of Jones County and State of N. Carolina being weak in body but of perfect sound mind and memory do make Constituted and Ordain this my last will & Testament in manner & form as follows that is principally and first of all I recommend my soul to God that gave it and my body to the Earth from whence it was taken to be buried in a decent form - I give & bequeath to my daughter Polly Ann one Shilling Sterling to her & her heirs forever - I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy right Cow & Calf during her widowhood and if she so remaining during her natural life for the use of Raising & maintaining of my two youngest Children also I send unto my beloved wife nine head of young Cattle for the use of clothing & schooling my two children also Thirty head of Hogs during her widowhood, also one mare and all my household furniture and plantation tools during her widowhood. My will and desire is that as much of the before mentioned property should be sold at six months credit as will satisfy all my

Just Debts and necessary expenses with what is now due me. I give & bequeath to my two children Nancy and Polly after my wife death or widow all the before mentioned property and its increase to them & their heirs & assigns forever - if in case of either of my children should die before they be of lawful age or having lawful heirs of their body my desire is that the surviving one shall have it & her heirs forever, Lastly I nominate and appoint my well beloved wife and my friend Jacob Jay my only Acting Executor to this my last will & Testament and hereby revoking all other wills and testaments made by me to be my last Will & Testament signed & published this 26th day of May 1809. I further desire that if either of my Executors should die or refuse to act I nominate and appoint my friend William Yates as one of my Executors to this my last Will & Testament.
