I Thomas Foy of Jones County and State of North Carolina
being Sick of Weak of Body though of sound of Reason
-ing Mind & Understanding & Calling to mind the mor-
-tality of this life do make public & declare my last
Will & Testament in manner and form following
(To Wit) I give & bequeath unto my Well beloved Wife
Elizabeth all the Cattle that was her property before our
Marriage also a Mare and Young Horse & one Horse Cattle
Jack which which were her property & besides other
namely Braz & Ribbands also one Hundred Pounds in
paper currency & twenty Barrels of Corn at the plantation
up front together with all the Wood & other Furniture
which which were her property at our marriage and one other
Bod of sheets Two Blankets of a day also twenty Barrels
of Corn where I now live & all my Meats but three
hundred weight also four Saw & Regs of one third of
my Sheep also one third Part of plantation & Utensils
& all the other Articles of all kind all which I give
to her my said her heirs & assigns forever -

Item I leave to my said Well Beloved Wife Elizabeth
the part of the plantation I now live on on the side
of the Road ^{near} my dwelling house the said land
to be ~~the road~~ to be the line during the term of
ten years or her Natural life (whichever I stand to
my De Wife Negro Sam & Sarah also Sam &
toys of his Wife Eve to have to her use & benefit
during her Natural life I then I give of Bequeath
-th to my Brother James Foy the Negroes following
namely Jacob & Leah also Sam and her Child
-ure Nig^r Pimus Sudee and Caesar Ruth & her
Children also Robin ^(Melstone) John his heirs and assigns
for ever - I then I give and Bequeath to my Brother
Frederick Foy Negro Hannah & her Children Nig^r.
Bill Henry & Manuel to him his heirs & assigns for
ever - I then All the residue of my Estate of
Nature or kind whatever not heretofore excepted
I will and Desire that it be Equally divided -
between my Brothers James & Frederick each as
well as person al of such Division I give to each of
them theirs and assigns forever - I then I give to
my Nephew Frederick Foy son of Jacob Foy one hun-
-dred pounds to be paid him in six year from this
Date out of my Estate in general - I then it is my
Will & desire it is my Will & Desire that old Robert
and his Wife here be & remain free from Slavery
hereafter - Lastly I do Nominate constitute and
appoints my Brothers James & Frederick Foy Executors
of this my last Will & Testament hereby Revoking all
former Wills by me made - In Witness

Then was the aforesaid last Will and Testament of Thomas Foy dec. duly proved in open Court by the Oath of Jesse Sanderson and Edward Quincy two of the subscribing Witnesses and ordered to be recorded. at the same time James Foy of Piedmont Foy the Executor therein named qualified as such agreeable to Law Ordered that letters Testamentary Issue accordingly -

Witness my hand & seal this 10th day of January 1790

Daniel Morrison of the County of Surrogate of North Carolina being weak in Body but of sound mind and memory do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in the following manner. I Will that my Just Debts be first paid. Then I Give and Bequeath to my friend John Witherson the sum of one thousand pounds Currency to be paid next out of my Estate. next I Give and Bequeath to my friend William Tyeanner the sum of fifty pounds & to my friend Lewis Bryan the sum of fifty pounds & to my friend

the sum of Twenty five pounds & to my friend Nathaniel Pulehard the sum of Twenty pounds & to my friend George Gardner the sum of Twenty pounds & to my friend Thos Richards on the sum of Twenty pounds and to my friend Benjⁿ Martin the sum of Twenty pounds of the overplus of my Estate of any to be divided among the several Legacies in the same proportion to the legacies of if about the same proportions of Discounts Except as to Mr. Witherson - Who is to be first paid & to receive his proportion of ~~any~~ over - Lastly I nominate & appoint my friend John Witherson & Lewis Bryan my sole sole Executors to this my last Will and Testament hereby Testifying & confirming this as true to be my last Will and Testament in Writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand & signed my seal this Eighth day of August Anno Dom. 1789
