

In the name of God Amen: I Thomas McDaniel of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory (blessed be God, do the ~~do~~ ^{25th day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty five 1855, make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner following, that is to say)}

Item 1st. I give and bequeath to my three sons Morris McDaniel, Thomas McDaniel and John McDaniel all of my lands to be equally divided between them.

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my son John McDaniel One Bed and Furniture and the sum of Two hundred Dollars current money.

Item 3rd I loan unto my daughter Leah Reynolds during her natural life, Negro girl Sarah and at her death, I give and bequeath said Negro together with his increase to the children of my daughter Leah Reynolds, provided any of the children live to the age of ten years at her death, if not said Negro or Negroes to go to my natural heirs.

Item 4th I loan unto my daughter Susan Margaret during her natural life Negro boy Morris for the benefit of herself and children and at her death I give and bequeath said Negro to the children of my daughter Susan Margaret, provided that any of her children live to the age of ten years at her death, if not said Negro to go to my natural heirs.

Item 5th I loan unto my daughter Mary Little Negro woman Mary and Child Italia together with their income for the sole benefit of Mary Little and children, and at her death I give and bequeath said Negro to the children of my daughter Mary Little, provided any of her children live to the age of ten years at her death, if not said Negro to go to my natural heirs.

Item 6th All of the balance of my property of every description not otherwise willed, I leave to be sold, and after all my just debts are paid the balance of the money if any to be equally divided between all of my children, on the same conditions as above written in distributing the different legacies.

And I hereby make and ordain my worthy sons Morris McDaniel and Thomas McDaniel Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
