 One thousand Eight Hundred & fifteen make publish and ordain this my
 last will and Testament in manner following that is to say first my
 Will & desire That my beloved mother shall have one hundred weight of
 Bacon and five Barrels corn also fifteen lbs. Hops Lard & seventy five
 pounds of flour also five hundred weight of Blade fodder also three sows
 now with pig also my Will and desire is for my beloved Wife Catharine to
 have One Hundred & Twenty five weight of bacon and Twenty weight
 of hops Lard and One Bed & Bedstead & Furniture also one cow and
 calf & One bow and earling and Five Barrels of corn & One sow & four
 pigs of the side Saddle and one Ch^{air} one plow and one preceding hoe
 my Will and desire is for the residue of my stock

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Goods and chattels to be sold and my just debts paid out of it and the balance of the money to be let out on Interest & the profits of the same to be applied to the use of schooling my beloved daughter Stacey and the principal to remain for her until she comes of age also my Will and desire is for my beloved wife Cathrine to have my lands during her Natural Life time or widow hood which is two Hundred and fifty acres more or less and after that for the said lands to descend to my daughter Stacey and be rented to the benefit of her her heirs & assigns for ever and I hereby nominate constitute make and ordain my worthy friend Benjamin Harrison and my wife Cathrine Executors to this my last Will and Testament whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written

In the name of God Amen I Mary Hay being sick and deboddy but of a perfect sound mind and memory do make this my last Will & Testament revoking all others Wills and knowing that we must all die do submit my soul to God that gave it and my body to the Earth from whence it came to be buried decently at the discretion of my Executors -
