a third patient and her Daughter Candace also one Negro Girl named
Barbuba one Bed and Furniture to her her Heirs and Assigns for ever
6th Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Miles Matlocke two Negro Girls
named Esther and Nancy one Bed and Furniture to her her Heirs & Assigns
for ever

7th Item I give & bequeath to my son Urban Fragar the House and plantation where
I now live, with the Land thereunto belonging excepting to be two Hundred & Eighty
acre less be the same more or less be him his Heirs & Assigns for ever

8th Item I give & bequeath to my son James Fragar & his heirs of Land lying on the
North side of Whitlock River joining Jeremiah Matlock's land and John
Benders land & the River containing two Hundred & 200 be the same more
or less to him his Heirs & Assigns for ever

9th Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Corena Day one Negro Girl
named Hannah Daughter of Dister to her her Heirs & Assigns for ever

10th Item I give & bequeath to my Grand Daughter Nancy Day one Negro Boy named
John Dinah Son to her her Heirs & Assigns for ever

11th Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Lucy Day Forty Pounds in
Money to be raised out of my Estate to her her Heirs and Assigns for ever

12th Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Sarah Gibson one Negro
Girl named Dolly to her her Heirs and Assigns for ever

13th Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Sarah Gibson one Negro Girl
named Lou to her her Heirs & Assigns for ever

14th I Desire that my three Negroes Simon Pigg Sam Little Sam be free out
annually and the Forty Pounds thereon arising the first day
May as her Legacy

15th Item I give & bequeath to my four children Urban Fragar James Fragar
Sally Fragar & Lucy Fragar Fourteen Fourteen Negroes namely
Lure pat, Anthony, Jacob, Abner, Luke, Ross, Noah, Lewis, Silas, Sam
Cornelius, Leskey and Charles to be Equally Divided among them as
they come of age that is when the oldest comes of age to have
his part & so on to the the youngest to them their Heirs and
Assigns for ever

I also Desire that all my Children that is under age
and for the support of her & the Children that live with her I
Desire she should keep a good stock of Horses Cattle Hogs Sheep
& all my plantation utensils and House hold Furniture with
my son Urban Arrives to full age and then to be Equally Divided
among my Four youngest Children Annually as they come to
full age or marriage to them their Heirs & Assigns for ever

I Desire that the Money's arising from the three Negroes here before
mentioned Simon Pigg Sam and Little Sam should be put to the use of
Schooling my four youngest Children until my son James comes of age

Item I give and bequeath to my son James Fragar when of full age two
Negroes Moll Simon & Pigg Sam to him his Heirs & Assigns for ever

I Desire that when my Daughter Sally comes to full age or marriage that
Little Sam should be sold at Public Sale & the Money to be Equally
Divided among my Five Daughters to them their Heirs & Assigns for ever

Lastly I nominate and appoint my Son Lot Fragar and
my son in Law Lot Matlocke & my son in Law Joseph

San derson and James Matlock Esq^s of this my last Will and
Testament Resolving all other Wills at any time before made
made by me Acknowledging this alone and no other to be my last
Will & Testament Signed Sealed in presence

There was the foregoing and certain last Will and Testament of Necimus
Fragar die duly Proved in open Court the first part by the Oath of
Samuel Hall one of the subscribing Witnesses and the second part or
Articles thereof proved by the Oath of Jeremiah Matlock one of the
subscribing Witnesses and ordered to be recorded, at the same
time Lot Fragar and Joseph Sanderson two of the subscribing Witnesses
then named Qualified as such Ordered that it be so

In the name of God Amen I Thomas Miller of the County of Jones
and State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory
Blessed be God. on the third day of November in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and Eighty eight make a last Will and Testament in manner following

1st I have unto my beloved wife Mary Miller all the Land and
plantation whereon I now live during her natural life with all
the Houses and appurtenances to the said Land belonging during
her natural life &c and after my widow's death I give all my
land and tenement with all the improvements to my Son James Miller
his heirs and assigns forever

2nd I bequeath to my wife Mary all my Stock of Cattle and Hogs during her
natural life and after her decease ~~to~~ of the Residue of said Stock
to be equally divided between my sons and Daughters share and
share alike except James Miller to whom I give my Land to him
his share of the Stock

3rd I bequeath to my beloved wife Mary all my Household and Kitchen Furniture
during her natural life and after her decease to be equally divided
between my sons and Daughters share and share alike

4th I give to my beloved wife Mary a young mare & tam'd. She
with a Colt during her natural life
5th I give to my son Lewis Miller a Horse called Mark to him his heirs
and assigns forever
6th I give to my son Martin Miller a Horse called Lantry to him his
heirs and assigns forever

7th I give to my wife Mary Miller all my stock of sheep to her & her
heirs & assigns forever
8th I give to my wife Mary Miller all my stock of sheep to her & her
heirs & assigns forever

And I hereby make and ordain my son Daniel Miller and my son
in Law Christian Henry Executors of this my Last will and Testament
In Witness whereof I the said Lewis Miller have to this my Last
will and Testament set my hand and seal the day and year above
written

James Stevenson two of the subscribing Witnesses in due form of
Law and ordered to be recorded at the same time Daniel
Miller and Christian Henry the executors named in said will
as such agreed to Law ordered that Letters Testamentary there
accordingly be granted

In the Name of God Amen I James Harrison Junior
of Jones County and State of North Carolina Being very weak
of Body But of sound and Perfect mind and Memory and
being well aware of the Mortality of my Body and knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to Die Do constitute make
and ordain this my Last will and Testament in manner and
form following that is to say Principally and first of all
I Recommend my Soul only to the hand of Almighty God who
gave it and my Body I Recommend to the Earth to be
buried in Decent Christian Burial at the Direction of my
Executors after Names Nothing Doubting But at the final
Resurrection I shall Receive the same again by the mighty
Power of God and as touching such worldly goods as
shall please Almighty God to Bless me in this Life

I give and dispose of in manner and form following
that is to say my will and desire is that my Just debts and funeral
Charges be paid by my Executors
Item I Give to my son William Harrison one Shilling Current money
I give to my son James Harrison one Shilling - I give to my
son John Harrison one Shilling Current money and I give to
my son Edward Harrison one Shilling Current money I
Give to my son Stephen Harrison one Shilling Current
money I give to my daughter Anne Harrison one Shilling
Current money

Item I Give to my son Richard Harrison fifty four acres of
Land Lying in Parkers Patent Beginning at a Red oak
near Heaters fence and Running about the red Swamp to a
Maple and an ash then to a small branch then with the run
of said Branch to the line of Parkers Patent then with the patent line
to the Beginning and I give to my son Richard Harrison another tract
parcel of Land containing forty acres of Land Adjoining the River and
Indels patent now Heaters land to him his heirs and assigns forever

Item I Give to my son Ephraim Harrison fifty four acres of Land on the west
side of Parkers Branch including my Plantation on said Branch
after the Expiration of my Wife's life time or widowhood and forty acres
of Land on the east side of Parkers Adjoining the Branch blackland
Simon Jacobs Land to him his heirs and assigns forever

Item I Give to my son Levi Harrison five hundred and five acres of Land including
my Plantation on Jumping Run after the Expiration of my wife's life or
widowhood to him his heirs and assigns forever

Item I Give to my Grand son James Harrison twenty four acres of Land on
Parkers Branch Beginning at a Red oak called the Standing Stone between
Shore Hightower and Sam Hill Running from thence with the line of
Parkers patent to a Red oak near Heaters fence then with the red Swamp
to a pine near Parkers Branch then a short line to a Maple then on
to a pine corner on the line of Parkers Branch then with the red Swamp to the
Beginning to him his heirs and assigns forever

Item I Give to my Daughter Lurana Harrison one fifth part of the Red and signature
to her her heirs and assigns forever
And the Remained third of my Personal property not mentioned here
to my wife During her Life or widowhood with one third part of my
Land on Jumping Run and one third part of my plantation
of Parkers Branch
And I do utterly Revoke and Intend all former wills and Testaments
Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my Last will and
Testament and I do nominate and appoint my son William Harrison
and my son James Harrison Executors to this my Last will and
Testament November the 30th 1781
