

273) I Urbane, Brazar being in sound mind and memory but weak in body do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking all others by me made, & touching my worldly affairs after my body is decently interred, it is my Will & desire that my Estate be distributed in manner I have following, Viz.

First - I give & bequeath unto my Mother Marya Brazar all my Stock of Hogs & Cattle, my riding gear, & Harnise, all my Corn & all my household furniture of every kind, to her & her Heirs for ever.

2^d - I give & bequeath unto my Sister Sarah Burnet my riding Horse, Saddle & Bridle, to her & her Heirs for ever.

3^d - I give & bequeath unto my Nephew Michajah Matticks Fifty pounds current Money to be paid by my Executors, to him & his Heirs for ever.

4th - I give & bequeath unto my Brother James Brazar, my Brother in law Pitts Oldfield, All my Tobacco, (namely) Lam, Pat, Cornelius, Jo, Grip, Israel & Seab; to be equally divided between them, to them, their Heirs & Assigns for ever. In like manner I give unto my Brother James Brazar & Brother in law Pitts Oldfield the Plantation whereon I live & all my Land in manner I have following, Fifteen hundred Dollars of the value of said Land, I give to James Brazar, & One thousand Dollars to Pitts Oldfield, or in the same proportion shall my Land be valued to more or less; they the said James Brazar & Pitts Oldfield to pay & discharge all my just debts jointly between them free & clear of any incumbrance, or post mortuary debt Legacy or bequeath by me given in this my Will, to them the said James Brazar & Pitts Oldfield their Heirs & Assigns for ever.

5th - I appoint & constitute my said Brother James Brazar my Brother in law Pitts Oldfield, my Executors to this my last Will & Testament, in Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand & fixed my Seal this 14th day of February, 1805. Signed, sealed & delivered in presence of the subscribing witnesses

I Hezekiah Merret Gent of Jones County S^c Carolina being weak in body, but of sound & perfect mind memory do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner I have following, Viz. - First it is my Will & desire that all my just debts I have of & paid by my Executors herein after named out of such part of my personal Estate as is not herein particularly devised, to wit -

1st - I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Pickens Fifty pounds Currency to be raised out of the Sales of such part of my Estate as is not herein after particularly devised, to her & her Heirs for ever.

2^d - I give & bequeath to my Son Hezekiah Merret One hundred Acres of Land on the upper end of the Survey of Land bought of David Smith between Henneper & Brainerd's Run Brackets adjoining part of the Lands where he now lives during his natural life, & after his death to my Grandson John Merret, Son of the said Hezekiah Merret, to him & his Heirs for ever. I also give & bequeath to my said Son Hezekiah Merret a young three year old Dick after my decease One Cow & Calf to him & his Heirs for ever.

3^d - I give & bequeath to my Daughter Sally Jett One Bed & Furniture to her & her Heirs for ever.

4th - I give & bequeath to my two Grand Children Baby & James Three One Cow & Calf each, & if either of the said Children should die before they arrive of age or marry, then the said property to go to the survivor of said Children, to them & their Heirs for ever.

5th - I give & bequeath to my Daughter Nancy Merret One Bed & Furniture, One Cow & Calf, One young three year old Horse & her Heirs & Assigns for ever.

6th - I give & bequeath to my Daughter Baby Merret One Cow & Calf, one Bed & Furniture, to her & her Heirs & Assigns for ever.

7th - I give & bequeath to my Daughter Phebe Merret One Feather Bed & Furniture, One Cow & Calf, to her & her Heirs and Assigns for ever, also a Mare called Jessi, to her & her Heirs for ever.

8th - I give & bequeath to my Daughter Hannah Merret One Bed & Furniture, One Cow & Calf, one Mare called a Springer, to her & her Heirs for ever.

9th - I give & bequeath to my Son James Merret the Lands and Plantation whereon I now live, together with the Lands bought of David Smith adjoining thereto, except one hundred Acres of the same I set herein before given to my Son Hezekiah Merret, One Bed & Furniture, & one Cow & Calf, & a Saddle all are left, to him & his Heirs & Assigns for ever.

10th - It is my Will & desire that all my Negroes be hired out until my youngest Daughter shall arrive to the Age of 21
