Carolina being sick and Weak in Body though
of Sound Mind and Memory and Calling to mind
the Mortality of this Life do make and Declare
this my last Will and Testament in manner follow-
ing (to wit) It is my Will that my Just Debts and
Funeral Charges be paid by my Executors out of what
Money I have without selling any of my Estate -
Then I give to my Well Beloved Wife Eliza all and
singular my Lands Goods and Chattels and all other
parts of my Estate of what nature or kind soever during
her Widowhood or Natural Life and no longer I do
give and Bequeath to my Well Beloved Wife the Land and
plantation I Bought of William Gibson lying at
the mouth of Backoon Creek to her her Heirs and
assigns forever - Then I give and Bequeath to my
Brother Levi Sanders my Great Coat my Cloth Little
Bodied Coat and my leather Boots to him and
his heirs and assigns forever - Then I Will that
my Executors make Levi Sanders a sufficient deed
for one half of the Land entered near Standburn
it being sixty four Acres - Then I Will that all
my Estate hereby lent to my Wife at her Marriage
or Decese be Equally divided ^{among} all my Children
or the Survivors of them and such part so Divided
I give his or her Heirs and assigns forever -
Lastly I do nominate and appoint my Brother in
Law Haden Knight Executor and my Well beloved
Wife Executrix of this my last Will & Testament

-tality of this life do make public & declare my last
Will & Testament in manner and form following -
To Wit I Give & bequeath unto my Well beloved Wife
Elizabeth all the Cattle that was her property before our
Marriage also a Mare and a young Horse & one Horse Cattle
Sack which which were her property & besides other
namely Bag of Ribbands also one Hundred Pounds in
paper currency & twenty Barrels of Corn at the plantation
up front together with all the Beasts & other Furniture
which which property at our marriage and one other
Bed sheets Two Blankets of a rug also twenty Barrels
of Corn where I now live & all my Meats but three
hundred weight also four Saw & Rags & one third of
my Sheep also one third Part of plantation & Utensils
of said having Articles of all kind all which I Give
to her my said her heirs & assigns forever -

Item I Give to my said Well Beloved Wife Elizabeth
the part of the plantation I now live on on the side
of the Road ~~next~~ my dwelling house the said land
to be ~~the road~~ to be the line during the term of
ten years or her Natural life (whichever I stand to
my Wife Negro Sam & Sarah also Sams &
toys of his Wife Eve to have to her use & benefit
during her Natural life - Item I Give of Bequeath
-th to my Brother James Foy the Negroes following
namely Jacob & Leah also Isaac and her child
-and Nig^r Pimus Isaac and Caesar Ruth & her
children also Robin ^(Melstone) John his heirs and assigns
for ever - Item I Give and Bequeath to my Brother
Frederick Foy Negro Hannah & her children Nig^r.
Bill Henry & Manuel to him his heirs & assigns for
ever - Item All the residue of my Estate of
Nature or kind whatever not heretofore excepted
I Will and Desire that it be Equally Divided -
between my Brothers James & Frederick each as
well as person al of such Division I Give to each of
them theirs and assigns forever - Item I Give to -
my Nephew Frederick Foy son of Jacob Foy one hun-
-dred pounds to be paid him in six year from this
Date out of my Estate in General - Item it is my
Will & desire it is my Will & Desire that old Robin
and his Wife here be & remain free from Slavery
hereafter - Lastly I do Nominate constitute and
appoint my Brothers James & Frederick Foy Executors
of the my last Will & Testament hereby Revoking all
former Wills by me made - In Witness whereof
