I, William Gilbert Gray junr of Jones County & State of Georgia
being aware of the duties of sound & perfect mind & memory do
make & ordain this my last will & Testament in manner and
form following

In primis, I give & bequeath to my Wife Percilla all my House-
 hold furniture of every kind, all my Plantation Tools of every
 kind, one head of two years old Hogs not salt, two Sows and
 eight young Shoats, or Hare call'd Ban, (preserving the felt
 that the said Hare is now big with for my Brother Thomas) I
 also give my said Wife two Cows, One Yearling & young calf
 & send unto my said Wife one third part of the Manor Plan-
 tation & land wheron I now live which descended to me
 by my Father's last Will during her natural life. I give unto
 my said Wife ten Barrels of Indian Corn & all the Meat
 which is said for family's use.

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It is my further Will & desire that my Executor herein named make a division of the personal Estate which descended by my Father's last Will between my Brother Parker Gray & myself together with the remaining part of the Estate which is yet unpaid between my said Father & myself, as also all the Stock & all other property remaining undivided, be divided by my Executor this part which may be so allotted off to my Estate be sold by Executor at six Months credit, & the Monies arising therefrom to be applied towards discharging my just Debts, & the residue to be applied to the use & benefit of my Child which my Wife is now pregnant with. I also desire that my Executor sell at six Months credit the fifty Acres of Land I bought of Henry Newby before mentioned, & that he execute a sufficient Deed of Sale therefor, & the Sale of the said Land I desire to be applied to the use of my Child before mentioned.

Lastly, I nominate, constitute, appoint my friend Sam. Hatch to be the Executor of this my last Will & Testament, ratified & confirmed under my hand & seal this 5th day of March 1880.
