barrels of Potatoes, one feather bed & furniture one cedar
Horn & Lamp during her natural life a wedlockhood bid
at her death or marriage to returne to my grand son
William Hawkins. Fifthly I give to my Son Benjamin
Hawkins one desk - Sixthly I give to my son Littleton
Hawkins one Room & Part all my house hold goods and
furniture with all my plantation tools & Stock of
my kind unles his brother Harryot should returne
in three years then he shall equally divide the whole
of that property with him Lands & all - I likewise
Constitute my beloved son Littleton Hawkins the sole
Executor of this my last Will & Testament and I do
hereby disallow Revok & disannull all & every other testa-
ment I have before begonne & done by me in anywise
named willed & bequeathed ratifying & Confirming this
and no other to be my last Will & Testament. Attn
Witness whereof I have signed & set my hand & Seal
this twenty fifth day of July in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred & nine.

In the name of God Amen
I Bazel Smith now being in a low state of
Health yet thanks to God of sound mind and memory
Calling to mind that I am liable to die do make and
appoint this my last Will & Testament in the manner
and form followingviz - First I command my
Body to the Earth to be buried at the discretion of my
Executor thereon after mentioned and as touching temporal
and gifts as it pleased you to bless me with. I hereby
bind give & bequeath in manner a form following
I wish my Son John Wm Smith to have the benefit of
labour of my Negro man Jim & his wife Tena the term
of two years to commence at the day of my death and
at the said time being out I wish the said Negro
Jim & his wife to be hired out and their wages to be paid
towards the payment of my debts then to my grandauncle
John Eliza Smith during his life and I give to my said
Son John Wm Smith his feather bed bedsteads of furniture
belonging to them marked J. W. S. and my boarful and
All in it and my large Mahogany dining Table
and two tea tables & six Silling Chairs such as he may
choose and two yoke of Oxen and ten Pairs with other
Lamb if they have any at the time of my death and
also all the Corn price and fodder & pastur that I am
possess of at my death to him and his heirs and assigns
for ever - And my negro woman Ann to be hired
out till my debts is all paid then I wish said negro
Ann to go to my grand Son Bazel Smith, and I give
to my Son John Smith five pounds to be paid in trust
to him in full with what I have already given him
All the rest of my payable property to be sold and the
money arising to go towards paying my just Debts and
I do hereby authorise and appoint friend General David
Hatch & my cousin Stephen & Tobie Executors to this my
last will & Testament. In testamony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & seal this 25th day June in 1811
