I William Jarman one of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind and memory blessed be God doth this thirtieth day of October in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty two make and constitute this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following viz

First I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rachel Jarman one Hundred acres of Land Whoseon I now live out of the lands that belong to Robert Jones dead, and the Harrow place and also all my Household and Kitchen furniture and also all my Plantation Tools and also one horn Bridle and Saddle and Indian Head of Hogs two sows and ten fattening Hogs and all my Crop borne fodder and peas and also six negroes namely Virgin Leon Clay Abel Edmund and Lucy forever and my daughter Rachel Jarman is to pay all my just debts. Then I give and bequeath unto my son Hards Jarman one Hundred Cow and ten dollars Cash to be paid him by my Executors. Then I give and bequeath unto my son William Jarman all the Harrow land except a part that I have given to my daughter Rachel to him his heirs and assigns forever. Then I give and bequeath unto my two daughters Pauline Jarman and Elizabeth Jarman all my Smith place lands to be equally divided between them to them their heirs and assigns forever. Then I give unto my daughter Pauline Jarman one Cow that I had of Graddy. Then I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Jarman one faded Cow. Then I give and bequeath unto my grand son Hope Jarman one negro boy Eliza to him his heirs and assigns forever and if he should die without lawful issue to return to my family. And I also nominate constitute and appoint my daughter Rachel Jarman and my friends Samuel Hatch and B. B. Hatch Executors to this my last Will and Testament. Rescinding all other wills by me heretofore made in witness whereof I have
