I do hereby Give and Bequeath to my Daughters
Elizabeth Ann & Mary Ann the sum of Fifty Acres of Land lying
the lines of John Anderson's land to her heirs
& assigns forever. I do hereby Give and Bequeath
to my Son John Ann the sum of all the residue
of my land together with the

Improvements not hereafter bequeathed to her
heirs & assigns for ever. Item I Will that my
well beloved Wife Ann Garrison have and
enjoy the use of my House Orchard and
Plantation & land also my Horses Cattle
Pigs & Sheep throughout her life & plantation
during her Natural life upon the
condition that she support & maintain my
Daughter William and at her decease I
Give the said Plantation & appurtenances
to my Son John Ann also my Horses and

Plantation otherwise to him his then
and assigns for ever upon Condition
that he said John Adam Grimes support
comfortably maintain my Daughter
William, Item I Give to my Wife
one Bed & Furniture, one Horse or Mare &
Saddle & Bridle also Negro Primmer to her
her Heirs and assigns for ever
Item, I Give and Bequeath to

Adam a young Black Man & his Wife
to him his Heirs & assigns for ever
Item, I Give and Bequeath to my Grand
Daughter Prudence Anderson one Bed &
Furniture to her her Heirs for ever
I have Touch of Children which I had by
my former Wife on Thelma having becom
ed them on life annuity, I Will that at
my Wife's Decease the Value of my goods and
 chattels be equally Divided between my
four Children Namely Anna Tudah Eliza
beth & John

in I Give & Bequeath to my Daughter
Hannah one Bed &c to her her Heirs and
Assigns for ever, Item I Give & Bequeath
to my Son John Down one Bed &c to him
his Heirs and Assigns for ever.

I do have my Executors Power either to sell
my Negro, Patterson and buy a Negro girl
for my Daughter, or to let him live with me &c
for her support. I Give my Son in Law John
Anderson the Note I had against him, I leave
the Corn & Wheat on the Plantation to Wife
for the use of the Family I Give each of my Children
the Cattle on his or her respective Mark.

I Do Revoke & Appoint my Will before
Wife Executors & Edward Whitty & John Anderson
Executors of this my last Will & Testament, Revoking
all former Wills by me made In Witness whereof
I have signed these presents with my hand
at that this 21st February 1790

Benjamin du? duly proved in open Court
by the Oath of Elyas Pepper, Shadrach Anderson
and Elyas Gamell the subscribing witnesses thereto

Same Instrument agreeable to Law, Ordered that
Letters of Administration be granted to the said
Anderson. Given under my hand and the Seal of the
Court this 13th day of May 1791
