Ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner following
I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God
that gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be
buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors
and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased
God to bless me in this life, I give devise & dispose of the same
in the following manner & form.

First I give and bequeath to Lucretia my dearly beloved wife
so long as she remains a Widow, after paying all my
Just debts, all my lands & negroes, household goods
personal & moveable Estate to devide among our
Children at her discretion and pleasure both before and
after they become of Age.
I But provide to my dearly beloved wife Lucretia
should marry, then I bequeath unto her a Childs
part, after time to by selling every thing & dividing the

The money equally amongst her & all our Children, Those that be of Age to receive their part & those under to have their part or parts put out at Interest until they become of Age.

3rd I hereby constitute make and ordain my eldest son Johnan & James H. Caldwell the sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament And I do hereby utterly disavow & revoke all former Testaments, Wills, Legacies an. Executors ratifying & Confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 4th day of July in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty seven Signed sealed & acknowledged
