In the name of God Amen. I. Your goodness of the  
County of Lincoln State of South Carolina being very sick and  
weak in body but of perfect mind & memory. Thank be to God  
calling unto mind the mortality of my Body do make and  
Ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner following

I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God  
that gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be  
buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors  
and at Touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased  
God to bless me in this life, I give devise & dispose of the same  
in the following manner of form.

First I give and bequeath to Lucretia my dearly beloved wife  
so long as she remains a widow, after paying all my  
just debts, all my lands & negroes. Household goods  
personal & moveable Estate to devolve among our  
children at her discretion and pleasure both before and  
after they become of age.

2<sup>d</sup> But provided my dearly beloved wife Lucretia  
should marry, then I bequeath unto her a childless  
son, whatsoeuer he shall bring carry thing & devide of the

The money equally among her & all our Children, Those  
that be of Age to receive their part & those under to have  
their part or parts put out at Interest until they  
become of Age.

I do likewise constitute make and ordain my eldest son  
Johanan & James Abbott Good, the sole Executors of this  
my last Will & Testament And I do hereby utterly rescind  
& revoke all former Testaments, Wills, Legacies or Executors  
ratifying & Confirming this & no other to be my last Will  
& Testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
hand & seal this Thirteenth day of September in the year of  
Our Lord One thousand eight hundred & thirty seven.
