our Lord One thousand eight hundred & fifty five make
and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner
following that is to say.

I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary
Keener all my Estate Real and Personal. Consisting of
two horse beast, Cattle, Hogs and Sheep, farming utensils
house hold and kitchen furniture, one wagon and one
windmill and all the grain on hand and all that is
growing and all and every thing of my worldly property
that I possess, But my three daughters Mary Sally
and Susanah is to have each of them one Sheep of
the aforesaid cattle and one Bed and Bedstead a
piece. — and after the death of my wife the property
then on hand, land and all to be equally divided
among all my Children. I appoint my two
sons Daniel Keener and Lewis Keener my Executors.
