 than the rest, each, having an equal share. I
 will that the land be not divided till the youngest
 comes of age. And I do hereby utterly disavow
 revoke & disannul, all other wills, testament
 bequests & Executors, and I do hereby constitute
 & ordain my worthy son Edward as will my son
 executor of this my last will & testament in writing
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
 1st day of February 1819 -
