

Andrew Ingles Will

State of North Carolina Lincoln County; Decr. 17th 1862.
Know all men by these presents that I Andrew Ingles being sound in
mind and perfect in my understanding make this my last Will &
Testament; First I bequeath to my wife Barbara Ingles all the Tract
of land upon which I now live containing one hundred & ninety acres
more or less for her to keep and to hold against any and all other
persons during her life time provided that she the said Barbara Ingles
bears my name and does not live in marriage with any one while
she lives. I also bequeath to my wife Barbara all the Hogs which I
now have being about nine in number also all of my Hogs and one
cow, one Mule and Mare and all of my farming tools and one small
Wagon & gears and all of my Household & Kitchen furniture & clothing
for my Daughters Sylvia and Catharine, I will & bequeath to them
one Bedstead & bed clothes for each of them, also to my daughter
Sylvia one large Black Heifer and to my daughter Catharine one
small Heifer for them to keep and to hold free from all claims
by any other person or persons whatever. I also will and bequeath to
each of my Children whose names are mentioned in this instrument
the sum of one dollar to be paid by wife Barbara to each and
every one of them as above stated. I also further wish that after
the death of my wife Barbara that my land upon which I
now live shall be equally divided among all my Children for
them to keep and to hold for their heirs administrators & assigns
I also bequeath to my wife Barbara all the Hogs and one cow and one Mare and all of my farming tools and one small Wagon & gears and all of my Household & Kitchen furniture & clothing for my Daughters Sylvia and Catharine, I will & bequeath to them one Bedstead & bed clothes for each of them, also to my daughter Sylvia one large Black Heifer and to my daughter Catharine one small Heifer for them to keep and to hold free from all claims by any other person or persons whatever. I also will and bequeath to each of my Children whose names are mentioned in this instrument the sum of one dollar to be paid by wife Barbara to each and every one of them as above stated. I also further wish that after the death of my wife Barbara that my land upon which I now live shall be equally divided among all my Children for them to keep and to hold for their heirs administrators & assigns

beats my name and does not join in marriage with any one while
she lives. I also bequeath to my wife Barbara all the things which I
now have being about nine in number also all of my Hogs and one
cow, one Mule and Mare and all of my farming stock and one small
Wagon & gear and all of my Household & Kitchen furniture excepting
for my Daughters Sylvia and Catharine, I will & bequeath to them
one Bedstead & bed clothes for each of them, also to my daughter
Sylvia one large Black Heifer and to my daughter Catharine one
small Heifer for them to keep and to hold free from all claims
by any other person or persons whatever. I also will and bequeath to
each of my Children whose names are mentioned in this instrument
the sum of one dollar to be paid by wife Barbara to each and
every one of them as above stated. I also further wish that after
the death of my wife Barbara that my land upon which I
now live shall be equally divided among all my Children for
them to keep and to hold for their heirs administrators & assigns
forever against all claims by any other person or persons what-
soever. Provided further that if my son David Engle returns
from the Confederate Army where he is now acting as a soldier
that after the death of my wife Barbara that he the said
David Engle shall have to keep and to hold for the benefit of
himself his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever
against all claims by any other person or persons whatever one
half of the Tract of land upon which I now live containing

One hundred & ninety nine years more or less, I Will & bequeath to my wife Barbara my Rifle Gun for her use and protection all of the foregoing statements Containce in this my last Will and Testament is made expressly for the manner and use in which I wish my property applied, In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal.
