

The following wills were proved in Open  
Court & admitted to Record, viz.

In the name of God Amen I christen & keepe  
of the County of Lancaster in the state of Penna. this day  
of Second Month of January. Meaning to mire the Mortality  
of my body & it is apposite to set all men onto the dead.  
this 9<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of our Lord A.D. 1827  
make & darre this my last will & testament as follows  
viz in the first place I commend my soul unto God who  
gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in a decent  
christianlike manner at the discretion of my executors  
the worldly effects wherinto it shall pleased God to  
bless me in this life with I do beg all due respects  
give the following manner to Mr. Etch & Etchall  
my just debts & funeral expenses to be paid. Secondly give  
bequeath unto my loving wife Sarah a negro woman  
named Jane now about twenty three years of age  
her children to Mr. Nancy about four years old Rosina  
about two years old. & her youngest child two males  
Doll & Billy her Saddle & Bridle one bed with attire  
clothing the bedstead four Cows four Sheep with all  
the future increase of the aforesaid property to devide  
as she may think fit also one year provision for self  
& family to be taken out of the stock & goods then  
hand also her spinning wheel the above property to  
give to my wife absolutely to do with as she think proper  
Secondly my will is that my three slaves Mariah  
about forty seven years of age Dick about forty five years  
of age Jane a mulatto boy about ten years of age  
my will is that the above slaves be emancipated & set  
at my decease & that my executors prepare a petition  
to the Superior Court of Pennsylvania praying the said  
Slaves to be liberated by further mention & known fact that they  
have done no harm more than usual care of the property  
in our declining years & bestowing more than twice their  
wages upon my said wife & her in all respects health &

more than unto all care of my Stock & other things for ever  
I suppose that the petition of freedom will be granted them this  
after my decease & provided the said slaves be set free by said  
Court then my will is that back of the legatee mentioned & in this  
my last will shall sign a bond or bonds for the good behavior  
of the said Negroes mentioned by the Court or my executors  
Upon their refusing so to do the legatees in legatees thus  
refusing shall forfeit his or her part of my estate & it shall  
be equally divided amongst those that do comply with  
my will & that the like forfeiture shall take place  
provided each legatee refused to sign a petition for the  
liberation of the above mentioned slaves aforesaid & provided  
that the said Court shalld fail to liberate the slaves  
aforesaid that this my will is that my executors & legatees  
shall present a petition to the next general assembly  
after such failure praying that the said slaves be set free  
On failure of any of the legatees refusing to sign said  
petitions that they shall not receive any part of my estate  
from my executors. If my will is that they who estate be  
left over with all the loss & expense in settling the said  
slaves free when the slaves is set free I will bequeath  
to Maria to the person above mentioned her bedding &  
Spinning wheel one year provision, with all  
her clothing Furniture, & such & bequeath to violet the  
person before named her bedding that she has of her own  
claims that is to say all the basin hangings with  
all the furniture of every kind her Spinning wheel & one year  
provisions my will is that the boy above named  
David be bound to some good trade by my executors until  
he arrives to the age of twenty one & he be instructed to  
Read the Gospel. My will is that all my wife have all my  
house & kitchen furniture of every kind also the lower  
part of the wagon with gear sufficient for two  
horses & the carriage which she left there to remain  
on the plantation for the use of my wife during her natural  
life there to be disposed of as she shall direct by another  
clause of my will is that my wife have the use

of all my plantations during her natural life & in the  
year of her death, as she thinks proper to alienate the  
remainder to be rented yearly by my executors  
but the rents arising from the Plantation to be wholly  
applied to the use of my wife. My will is that  
my wife have as many of the plantation tools as it  
is sufficient for her service during life my will is that  
my executors sell all the remainder of my personal estate  
that is not mentioned in this my will upon a reasonable  
credit by taking bond with a friend security & the  
money arising from the sale my will is as follows  
after paying all my just debts & funeral charges & full  
the expense of the freedom of the negroes above mentioned  
My will is that the money arising from the property  
not before mentioned in this my will that be be  
equally divided between Peter Baker son of my brother  
John Peter Baker, to Peter Isaac, son of John & Barbara  
Stewart to Christy Baker Hartnight to Christopher Baker  
son of my brother Michael Baker to Sarah Carpenter  
wife of Christy Carpenter to Catherine Stuttle wife  
of Samuel Stuttle, my will is that my executors of this  
will shall at the death of my wife sell all my real &  
personal estate that I have not heretofore sold  
and the greatest credit during my life time shall be  
offered in giving away personal or real estate on a reasonable  
credit by the purchaser giving bond with a friend  
security & two others thereof be equally divided between  
Peter Peter, son of my brother John Peter Peter &  
Peter Isaac son of John & Barbara Isaac, Christopher  
Baker Hartnight & Christopher Baker son of my  
brother Michael Baker & Sarah Carpenter wife of  
Christy Carpenter & Catherine Stuttle wife of  
Samuel Stuttle, my will is that the money arising  
from the first clause of this my will coming to  
Catherine Stuttle shall be paid out in her purse

a small tract of land the title to be made to her  
to be held along with the money arising from both clauses of  
this my will to Peter & Charles Murphy but that my  
executors keep the money at interest until to the day  
Peter & Charles arrive to the age of twenty one years  
of age & the interest arising from the money arising  
to be applied for the education of said Peter & Charles  
My will is it is my desire that my wife make a will  
testament & appoint her executors in order that she  
may dispose of the property that I have herein before  
left her also the third part of the talk mentioned & all  
of personal & personal property that I have not  
herein before disposed of with all the rest of them  
that may be on hand at my wifes decease

My last request to my executors is that they never fail  
to take care of the aforementioned slaves for it is my own  
will they never serve any person after my death  
but they do hereby constitute & appoint Jacob Parsons  
notation in witness to Peter Murphy Esq's  
of witness of this my last will & testament & I do  
hereby make & declare & disannul all former  
will hitherto made by me I declare this to be  
my last will & testament signed sealed published  
and declared to be Christian Eakes to be his last  
will & testament in presence of us

Major Hull Sarah C. A. B. the undersigned  
Samuel Wilson Jr. do before me do sign and during  
John Cook my lifetime shall do off  
or give away personal or  
real estate acknowledged  
before me the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June  
1829
