

G. L. Ramsour's Will.

I hereby nominate & appoint my wife Julia as Executrix, and my brother-in-law Theodore G. Ramsour as Executor to execute this Will.

I hereby publish & declare this to be my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking all other or former wills by me made.

It is my solemnly sworn wish that God has blessed me; I desire
it to be disposed of as follows. viz.

I give to my niece Emma E. Ramsour (daughter of my Sister
Mally C. Ramsour deceased) one thousand Dollars, to be paid
over to her out of my Estate by my Executors as soon as
convenient.

All the balance of my Estate both Real and
Personal, I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Julia C. E.
Ramsour. and after all my debts are paid, she is to dispose
of it as she sees proper.

I hereby nominate & appoint my wife Julia as Executrix, and
my brother-in-law Theodore J. Ramsour as Executor to execute
this will.

I hereby publish & declare this to be my last Will & Testament.
I hereby revoking all other or former wills by me made.
