

The following Will was proved in open Court
at April Term 1827 & admitted to Record

In the Name of God Amen

I Charles H. Hager, do make and establish this
My Last Will and Testament in the manner & form following
Viz In the first place; It is My will and desire that My wife
Polly possess and enjoy the use of the house in which I
live and the fields around the house and barn & which she
has lately attended and do have and possess all the other
tenements attached to same for and during her natural
life or Widewidow — It is also My will that she choose
and select such articles of the household & kitchen furniture
as she may desire, and such part of the stock of Cows
hogs and sheep and so much ^{of the} provisions of every kind on
hand as she may think necessary and proper for her support
& Maintenance, in and during her natural ^{life} and after her
death to be sold and equally divided among all My children
and I give ^{and bequeath} unto My sons William Hager & John Hager the
whole of the tract of Land on which I live with the several
parts My wife as aforesaid, to be ^{divided} laid off as to make each part
as nearly equal in Quantity & Value as possible John to have
the upper end and William the lower and as they are
now divided, the division line to begin in the line on the
west side of the Creek & running thence easterly, across the
Creek towards Pallocks or Nixons line as the case may be
and it is also My will that My son John have the young
gosh
and it is My will & desire in addition to what My
Daughters Polly, Edleman, Mary Bryson, & Elizabeth Hager
have already received, that they each receive out of My estate
the further sum of twenty five Dollars
4th It is My will and desire that My daughter Winney and
Polly Hager shall have forty Dollars each, & a Cow & Calf
and such other property as My other daughters received when
they married & went off My Daughter Winney to keep these
things she has in possession

at part of her portion - & it is further My will and
desire that My said daughters Winney and Sally
live on the place and enjoy and possess the use
of all things left to My wife as long as they remain single

3th It is My will & desire that as My wife Betsey does
not wish to keep a house, that both My horses and
such other part of My stock of any kind after My
wife takes such as she ^{may} please and such other property
not specially Willed, to be sold at publick sale & with
the Money on hand, or notes due me after paying
all My last debts if any should remain unpaid & after
paying the Legacies mentioned above then the Remainder
to be equally divided among all My Children equally &
including also in this division My wife Betsey

6th It is also My will and desire that as long as she remain
in possession of the houses and Lands as above Willed to her
during her natural life or widowhood that she or My
daughters Winney and Sally as the case may be
shall be at liberty to cut fire wood or timber for the
Repairing of ^{the} houses or houses on any part of the tract

And lastly I do hereby appoint My son William Hager
Henry Estleman Executors of this My last will and
testament, hereby disannulling and Revoking all others
by me made and ratifying with confirming the same
As witness My hand ~~hand~~ and seal this 19th March
1807 signed sealed, published & declared as his last
Will & testament in presence of us ^{his} Christopher Hager (Seal)
