Robert all Gifford Esq sworn

In the name of God amen I Christina Bandy of Lincoln County
State of New Hampshire being naked in body but of sound
mind and of a disposing mind and memory do make
and Ordain this my last will & testament and do hereby
dispose of my worldly estate in manner & form following
viz after all my just debts to be paid out of my estate
I give and bequeath unto my daughter Susannah
Bandy the two & three bedsteads & furniture also ^{one} wheel
and two & two of the best chairs also two
large wash pot. The following property viz in the
property of Susannah Bandy and I the said Christina
Bandy have no claim title or as she the said Susannah
has made or bought it with her own labors viz three
head of cattle also five head of sheep one chest
one long wheel also two tables & kitchen and furniture
one loom & spool wheel also four blankets also
four bedquits also eleven shawl & also give and bequeath
unto my daughter Susannah all my bed clothes & quilt
what will furnish one bed which is to be sold
I also wish the balance of my worldly estate to
be sold & divided equally amongst all of my
children namely Thomas William George & John
Chalkey Polly Elizabeth Sarah Nancy Katharine
Elizabeth Susannah Bandy and I do hereby
ordain constitute and appoint my son Thomas
Bandy my sole Executor to execute this my
last will and testament and in testimony
hereof I do hereby set my hand and seal
this 28th of 1830
