

Daniel M. Weaver's Will

State of N. Carolina, Lincoln County, March 21st 1862

I, Daniel M. Weaver of said County do make this my last Will & Testament.

1st I devise and bequeath to my wife Eliza M. Weaver and her heirs forever all my Real Estate, which consists of two tracts of Land lying in the County of Lincoln. One tract contains about 120 acres and lies on the waters of Howard's Creek and adjoins the lands of David Hoover and others, and was purchased by me from Elizabeth Sharp the boundaries of which tract are mentioned in the deed of the said Elizabeth Sharp bearing date on the 3rd day of April 1839. The other tract also lies on the waters of Howard's Creek and contains about 55 1/2 acres and adjoins the lands of Saml. Eaman S. W. Mauney & Levi Houser. And was purchased by me from Samuel Eaman and the boundaries of which are mentioned in the deed of the said Eaman dated 4th day of February 1861.

2^d I do hereby will & bequeath unto my said wife forever all my personal Estate, to wit all my Cattle, Hogs, all my household & kitchen furniture, farming tools all notes and accounts due me and all my money and all the rest and residue of my personal estate together with the increase thereof.

3^d I do hereby appoint my said wife executrix of this my last Will & Testament and I do hereby revoke all other Wills by me heretofore made, In Witness Whereof I do hereunto set my hand & seal

The foregoing last Will & Testament was signed by us in the presence of each other & in the presence of the Testator who then acknowledged

55 1/2 acres and adjoins the lands of Saml. Eaman & J. W. Mauney & Levi Houser. And was purchased by me from Samuel Eaman and the boundaries of which are mentioned in the deed of the said Eaman dated 4th day of February 1861.

2^d. I do hereby will & bequeath unto my said wife forever all my personal Estate, to wit all my Cattle, Hogs, all my household & kitchen furniture, farming tools all notes and accounts due me and all my money and all the rest and residue of my personal estate together with the increase thereof.

3^d. I do hereby appoint my said wife Executrix of this my last will & Testament and I do hereby revoke all other wills by me heretofore made, In Witness Whereof I do hereunto set my hand & seal

The foregoing last will & Testament was signed by us in the presence of each other & in the presence of the Testator who then acknowledged the same to be his last will and Testament.
