

21 July Sessions 1825

In the name of God Amen

I Daniel Spivey of Lincoln County and State
of North Carolina do make my last will and
Testament that is to say after all my lawfull
debts are paid I give and bequeath to my beloved
wife Nancy I give my house and plantation
on which I now live together with one black man
named Stephen and also two horses with ironing
and also two cows to possess and enjoy as her
own together with the house property so long as
she natural life or widowhood. ^{And} It is my
desire after my death that all the property not
included in the above gift to my wife should
be sold at public sale and the monies arising
therefrom put to interest till my youngest
child comes to age and that no spirituous liquor
be sold or given away on the day of sale
I give and bequeath to my son Francis Spivey one
hundred and fifty dollars which I paid for him
to John Green in Charlotte

I give and bequeath to my son James S. Spivey
my watch and one hundred dollars to be paid
him out of the residue money.

I give and bequeath to my son Henry Spivey
two hundred and fifty dollars which I paid
for a tract of land the bought of John Deenan

I give and bequeath to my son Wesley Spivey one
hundred dollars to be paid him out of the residue money.

Also one house to be worth fifty dollars when
he comes of age also a bed
After my death and my wife's death I give
the quarter to my three youngest sons that is to say
My son Affrey, William & Henry & I Fletcher
Affrey has hundred & forty acres of land the
plantation in which I now live to the same
amount. I also I give to the above three youngest
sons each a hundred acres of land to be a part of my
estate. I give to William 60 acres & Henry 60 acres
each one hundred & thirty acres more of which
land to be equally divided between the three
youngest sons, to have 40 acres each
And after the death of my wife I give the quarter
to my three daughters that is to say Martha & Anne
& Mary, Susanna & William and I Mr. Coe takes
all the house hold goods then remaining in the
house by my wife's & my wife's riding saddle
she will dispose of her saddle as she thinks proper to
be divided equally among my three daughters such
as beds & furniture, beams, table, chairs, chests
table & kitchen furniture. I give the quarter to all my boys
to be equally divided among my seven sons, James, Thomas, I,
Henry, William, Minam, William, & Fletcher. This my last
will & testament if there be any man, property not disposed
of, let it be divided equally among all my seven daughters
in order thus my last will may be fulfilled by my sons & my
daughters. I give to my son Henry & my daughter Mary & my daughter
Elizabeth. I give to my daughter Mary & my daughter Elizabeth
