Daniel Leophardt's Will

In the name of God Amen. I Daniel Leihardt of the County of Lincoln and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following That is to say
First That my Executors (hereinafter named) shall provide for my body a decent burial and pay all funeral expenses, together with my just debts whatsoever and to whomsoever owing out of the moneys that may first come into their hands as a part or parcel of my Estate
Item I give and devise to my beloved wife Obadience one negro girl named Frances and also a negro boy named Benjamin. Also she is to have full possession of the house in which I now live and all the household and kitchen furniture of every kind and description. Also I direct that my beloved wife shall receive a full and comfortable support off the plantation on which I now live, the above named property she is to hold during her natural life and at her death to be sold and the proceeds thereof equally divided between my three daughters, viz, Elizabeth Jane Bestary Mosteller and Abigail Porter

Item I give and bequeath to my son Wesley the plantation on which I now live containing 143 Acres be the same now or hereafter another tract of Land known as the Maceltemar plantation joining

another Tract of Land known as the Macellenas plantation joining
lands of Wilson and others containing 125 Acres to the same more or
less, also another Tract of land known as the Jacob Linhardt plant-
ation joining lands of Jacob Linhardt and others containing 177-
Acres to the same more or less, Also I give unto my son Mely a
Negro boy named Samuel. Also all the black Smith Tools and Stell and
Vessels and all the farming tools and utensils of every kind and
description Also choice of my Waggons one black mule known
by the name of Tom one bay horse four y^r & old named Charly
Also one half of my Stock of Cattle Sheep and Hogs. I Also give
and devise to my son Mely all the growing crop and all the grain
of every kind together with all the products of the farm of every
description that may be on hand at my death.

Item. I give and bequeath To my daughter Abigail Porter one cow
and calf one year and lamb and one sow to make her equal
with what I have heretofore given my other two daughters.

Item I give to my Grand Son Daniel Sain one roan horse two years
old saddle and bridle. provided he will pay to my Grand Son
Daniel Porter the sum of twenty five dollars. should said Daniel
Sain agree to do so then in that case he shall pay said amount
over to William Leichard whom I hereby appoint Guardian for
said Daniel Porter and he shall keep said sum at interest until
Daniel Porter arrives to the full age of twenty one years, should Daniel
Sain not agree to pay said Daniel Porter twenty five dollars then
in that case I direct the horse to be sold and the proceeds

Equally divided between Daniel Skinn and Daniel Porter
Porter part placed in the hands of Mrs. Leubhardt as her sole dispo-
sition. I hereby direct my Executors to see a Tract of Land that I now
own known as the Connor plantation lying at the Head of Muddy
fork joining lands of James Connor Ironbarges and others con-
taining 136. Acre more or less and the proceeds thereof I request
to be equally divided between my son Wesley and my three Daughters
Viz. Elizabeth Skinn Barbary Mosteller and Abigail Porter
I am my will & desire is that all the lands and the negro Boy Samuel
that I now will to my son Wesley provided he should die before his
present wife and without any lawful heir or heirs in that case the
lands and said negro boy I direct to be sold and the proceeds
thereof Equally divided between my three daughters Viz. Elizabeth Skinn
Barbary Mosteller and Abigail Porter.
I am the proceeds of my sale together with what Cash and notes I may
have on hand at my decease after paying off all just claims and
demands that may come against my Estate I direct to be equally
divided between my three daughters Viz. Elizabeth Skinn Barbary
Mosteller and Abigail Porter. And lastly I do hereby constitute
and appoint my son Wesley and my son in Law Abram Skinn my
lawful Executors to all intents and purposes to execute this my last
will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning
of the same and every part and clause thereof hereby revoking
and declaring utterly void all other wills and Testaments by me
made in witness whereof I the said Daniel Leubhardt
do hereby sign and seal this March the 24th day AD 1860

I am The proceeds of my Sale together with what Cash and what I may have on hand at my decease after paying off all just Claims and demands that may come against my Estate I direct to be equally divided between my Three Daughters, Viz. Elizabeth Sain Barbary Mosteller and Abigail Porter. And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Wesley and my son in Law Abram Sain my lawful Executors to all intents and purposes to execute this my last Will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof hereby revoking and declaring utterly void all other Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made in witness whereof I the said Daniel Leonard do hereunto set my hand and seal this March the 14th day A.D. 1860 signed sealed published and declared by the said Daniel Leonard to be his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who at his Request and in his presence do subscribe

our names as Witnesses thereto.
