I give them in lands & other property that I deem
suitable - Thirdly very well is that, the balance of
my property to be sold at public sale & the balance
of my just debts being paid to be given to my
daughter Elizabeth -

1825 at the County of Lincoln &c. My son Henry
Worthing of this my last will and testament &c
I have signed. I have said Daniel Worthing, have to this
last will and testament set my hand &c I seal the
