gun & shot bag a silver watch & all the debts of hand
that are owing to me my look account & all things
deceased I have against the people also a cross
two pensils that is at Henry Smiths that I bought
of Jacob Burnes & four head of hogs that is at
Henry Smiths that I bought of Jacob Burnes also
my ^{old} & a side saddle that she has formerly
claimed & all that is in my smoke house that
belong to me two wash pots a gring stone
Hunting box all the above called property my land up
Margaret Sullivan is to have & to hold while she continues
in her widowhood if she shall marry again all the
above property I have called her shall be paid by order
of the County Court of Lincoln & the money to be divided
amongst my children each child to share & share alike
& I hereby make & ordain my beloved wife Margaret Sullivan
executrix of this my last will & testament in testimony
whereof I have signed this my last will &
testament at my hand the day & year above mentioned
