I David Carpenter of the County of Elizabethtown  
 State of North Carolina, being the infirmities of age  
 & the afflictions incident to human beings and  
 And knowing that it is appointed to all men once to  
 die and bring most of some I disposing of my<sup>1</sup> Memory &  
 I do hereby declare that it is my will to  
 to dispose of the property wherewithal it has pleased God  
 to bless me in the following manner. Viz. My body  
 I wish to be buried in a decent & Christian like  
 manner. And my spirit I give into the hands of  
 my Saviour Jesus Christ. And as touching the  
 property which I own. First I give to my beloved  
 wife Elizabeth Carpenter two beds of furniture one  
 Bureau and a side cupboard and half the cupboard  
 and kitchen furniture one table one room in the  
 House we now live in such one as she may choose  
 provided she remains on the plantation with our  
 son Michael Carpenter and if she should choose  
 to leave there I go to some other place to live she  
 is not to have any of said property Except the beds  
 & bureau and if she should leave the plantation and  
 go to live with some other of our children my son  
 Michael shall furnish her annually with ten  
 bushels good wheat or two barrels good flour twenty  
 bushels good corn

and knowing that it is appointed to all men once to  
die and being now of sound & disposing mind &  
memory I do hereby declare that it is my will too  
to dispose of the property wherewithal it has pleased God  
to bless me in the following manner. Viz. My body  
I wish to be buried in a decent & Christian like  
manner and my spirit I give into the hands of  
my Master Jesus Christ. And as touching the  
property which I own. First I give to my beloved  
wife Elizabeth Carpenter two beds of furniture one  
Bureau and a side Cupboard and half the Cupboards  
and Kitchen furniture one Table one Room in the  
House we now live in such one as she may choose  
provided she remains on the plantation with our  
son Michael Carpenter and if she should choose  
to leave there I go to some other place to live She  
is not to have any of said property except the beds  
& Bureau and if she should leave the plantation and  
go to live with some other of our children my son  
Michael shall furnish her Annually with Ten  
bushels good Wheat or two barrels good flour Twenty  
bushels good sound Corn two hundred weight good  
~~good pork~~ one hundred weight beef fifteen pounds  
coffee twenty five pounds good sugar one pound  
one pound pepper & a Cepice Each half bushel salt  
two gallons Wine two gallons good Whiskey or Brandy

Should she remain on the plantation with our  
 Son Michael she may have one third of the  
 Plantation we now live in if she chooses And if she  
 remains with Michael he is to have her  
 Washing And if necessary her Cooking done for  
 her She is also to have an Equal Share that is a  
 Childs part of all the balance of my Estate not  
 otherwise specially disposed by this will And then  
 she is to have let her go where she will  
 as well as if she remains with Michael  
 Second I give to my Son Michael Carpenter  
 the plantation where he now livs Containing  
 by Estimation two hundred Acres lying on the  
 West Side of Blacks Creek joining lands of  
 Michael Summerow Michael Reinhardt John  
 Edine Solomon Carpenter & John Morris all the  
 borders Except one that may belong to me at  
 my decease a Still flake Ham & eight hogsheads  
 of side cupboard & half the furniture one half the  
 Kitchen furniture my Road Waggon & four sets  
 of horse gear his choice an Iron tools harrow  
 & mattock & pitch fork dung fork & shovel  
 my Crop Cut Saw & my negro man named  
 Charles my Negro boy named Richard my Negro  
 woman named Matty & her child named  
 Matty And all the children she may have hereafter  
 my negro & black wif Tidye & her child

Washing Anna if necessary her Cleaning done for  
her. She is also to have an Equal Share, that is a  
child's part of all the balance of my Estate not  
otherwise specially disposed by this will stand there  
she is to have let her go to live where she will  
as well as if she remains with Michael

Secondly I give to my Son Michael Carpenter  
the plantation whereon I now live containing  
by Estimation two hundred Acres lying on the  
West side of Clark's Creek joining lands of  
Michael Summerow Michael Reinhardt John  
Cline Solomon Carpenter & John Morris all the  
horses Except one that may belong to me at  
my decease a Still flake Hove & eight hogsheads  
of rice upboard & half the furniture one half the  
Kitchen furniture my Road Waggon & four sets  
of horse gear his choice an Iron tooth harrow.  
& mattock & pitch fork dairy fork & shovel  
my Crop Cut Saw. And my negro man named  
Charles my Negro boy named Richard my Negro  
woman named Matty & her child named  
Hatty and all the children she may have hereafter  
my sett. of Blacksmith Tools my clock & Case and  
half my flock of cattle sheep and hogs  
Thirdly to my Daughters viz Polly Rhodes Catherine  
Rhodes and Elizabeth Moyle I give the proceeds  
of the sale of my three negroes (slaves)

Eliphalet Bachelder & Nancy to be sold amongst my  
Heiresses not to be sold to strangers or any other  
person the same to be Equally divided Amongst my  
said three daughters or their children  
Fourth) To my wife three daughters Polly Catherine  
Elizabeth or their children I give all the balance  
of my land not otherwise disposed of in this Will  
to hold the same as tenants in common they may  
if they choose divide the land or they may sell  
it & divide the proceeds Equally.

Fifthly, sell the balance of my Property to be  
sold at publick sale and the proceeds thereof  
together with all the cash funds after all  
my just debts & funeral Expences are paid is  
to be Equally divided between my wife Elizabeth  
Carpenter my son Michael Carpenter & my  
daughters Polly Rhodes Catherine Rhodes Elizabeth  
Hoyle or their children

Sixth,) After the decease of my wife Elizabeth all the  
Property I have given her is to be sold & the proceeds  
of the sale together with the money she may have  
on hand is to be Equally divided Amongst  
all our children.

I do hereby nominate and appoint my son Michael  
Carpenter and my son in law Henry Rhodes my  
Executors to execute this my last Will & Testament

Fourth) To my three daughters Polly Carpenter  
Elizabeth & their children I give all the balance  
of my land not otherwise disposed of in this will  
to hold the same as tenants in common they may  
if they choose divide the land or they may sell  
it & divide the proceeds Equally.

Fifth) Sell the balance of my property to be  
sold at publick sale and the proceeds thereof  
together with all the cash funds after all  
my just debts & funeral expenses are paid is  
to be Equally divided between my wife Elizabeth  
Carpenter my son Michael Carpenter & my  
daughters Polly Rhodes Carpenter Rhodes Elizabeth  
Hoyle & their children

Sixth) After the decease of my wife Elizabeth all the  
property I have given her is to be sold & the proceeds  
of the sale together with the money she may have  
on hand is to be Equally divided among  
all our children.

I do hereby nominate and appoint my son Michael  
Carpenter and my son in law Henry Rhodes my  
Executors to execute this my last will & testament  
and do hereby revoke disannul & disallow all  
other former wills by me made and hereby declare  
publickly ratify this as my last will and testament  
in writing whereof I David Carpenter have here  
unto set my hand and affixed my seal
