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The following Will was read in open Court & admitted to record

In the name of god Amen I David Hollinger of Lincoln & North Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind and perfect memory do make and publish this my last Will & testament to wit. I give bequeath and devise all my estate both real & personal to my beloved wife Sarah. During her life or widowhood and at her death or marriage to be distributed according to the laws for the distribution as the estate of intestates. She is to have the sole management of my estate except what is hereafter expressed. During the period above mentioned named to collect all debts owing to me to delay my funeral of persons to pay all my debts and to educate & bring up our savings & children. Should it be her desire that my negro woman Tabella & Child should & income be hired that should it be my wife that my executor hereafter named live or sell the same as she may direct & apply the proceeds accordingly to the above devise.

It is further my Will that Henry Canaler & Isaac Finger be my Executors of this my last Will & testament and I do hereby revoke all former Wills by me made.
