In the name of God Amen I David Harmon
of the County of Lancaster and State of Pennsylvania
Being weak of body yet of perfect sound Mind and
Memory; blessed be God do this 19th day of October in the
Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and
Eighteen make my last will and testament in manner
and form following (viz) first I give and bequeath to
my wife Sarah Harmon two hundred Acres of land
whereon I now live, including my present plantation
by her freely to be enjoyed during her life with this except-
ion, that if any of my Children diee proper attention
or Battaliate aly of the unimproved Lands they shall be
intituled to the privilege of doing it so at most to interfere
with the present plantation, during my wife natural life
and after her decease to be equally divided among they
Children, 2d I give & bequeath to my wife two hundred
Acres, Beasts, all my Stock of Cattle &c &c my
house hold furniture, & farming Utencils, & working tool
to be disposed by my wife among my Children as they come
of age, at her discretion also she is to give them Education
as far as her circumstances will admit, until their become fit to go
to some trade, at which time it shall be left to my executors
what trade they shall be put to, also I direct my executors
to dispose of some of my property such as can be best
spared from the use of my family, to the discharging
of just debts, and I hereby make & ordain my brother
friend Richard Harmon and my wife Sarah
Harmon, executors of this my last will & testament
in witness whereof he the said David Harmon
particulars set his hand and affixed his seal the
day & year above written signed in the presence
of us who were present at the sealing & delivering hereof
