Being weak of body yet of perfect Sound Mind and
Memory, Blessed be God do this 19th day of October in the
Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and
Eighty one make my last will and testament In manner
and form following (VIZ) first I give and bequeath to
my wife Sarah Harmon two hundred Acres of land
whereon I now live, including my present plantation
by her self to be enjoyed during life with this excep-
tion, that if any of my Children see proper to settle on
or better able able of the unimproved lands they shall be
intitled to the privilege of doing it so as not to interfere
with the present plantation, during my wife's natural life,
and after her decease to be equally divided among my
Children, 2nd I give & bequeath to my wife two hogs of
horns, Beasts, all my Flocks of Cattle, Hogs, all my
house hold furniture, & farming utensils, & working tools,
to be disposed by my wife among my Children, as they come
of age, at her discretion also she is to give them Education
as far as Circumstances will admit, until they become fit to go
to some trade, at which time it shall be left to my Executors
what trade they shall be put to, also I direct my Executors
to dispose of some of my property such as can be best
spared from the use of my family, to the discharging
of Just debts, and I hereby make & ordain my worthy
friend Richard Harmon and my wife Sarah
Harmon Executors of this my Last will & Testament
in witness whereof he the said David Harmon
hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the
day & Year above written signed in the presence
of us who were present at the sealing & delivering hereof
