In the name of God Amen,

In the name of God Amen
I David Hawn of the County of Lincoln
State of North Carolina being weak in body
but of a sound & perfect mind & of a good
understanding & knowing that it is appointed me
for all men to die, I do hereupon appoint this my
last Will & Testament revoking all others.

I will that all the Land I own shall be
divided equal between the five boys that is
John Henry Daniel Jesse and David & in value
and them that got ^{no} breast, & them that got no
breast shall have Eighty Dollars, for to make them
equal with them that got a breast & Henry Daniel
Jesse & David shall have the Value of one
Cow & Calf & also a Bedstead & bed clothing
for to make them equal with John & each of
the four boys shall have two hogs apiece
to make them equal with John & I will that
the five boys John Henry Daniel Jesse & David
shall pay for dividing the land, Between
themselves or their Guardians & I will that
all my loose property be sold with the exception
of one of my horses which I will unto my
son Henry & I will that he shall take choice
of them all & the money be divided between
the four girls Elizabeth Catharine Polly
& Anne after the Court Charges is paid

But I Will that Polly shall have twenty five
Dollars more than Elizabeth, & Catharine because
Elizabeth & Catharine got a crust & I will that my daug.
-her Amy shall have fifteen Dollars more than Elizabeth
& Catharine because Amy got no Crust, But I will
that the boys, Henry, Daniel, John & David shall have
them money out of it first to make them equal
With John & further I will that my Clothing and
all the Cloth that is here shall be divided between
the four boys Henry, Daniel, John & David & I will
that my son Henry shall pay my debts & collect
all that is due me, & after my decease what money
is left shall be divided between Henry, Daniel,
John & David by the money I have by me & due me.
Also Will that the Wheat Corn Oats & Hay
that the four boys raise this season shall be
divided between them selves. Henry, Daniel,
John & David each one have a share, & I
also Will that after my land is divided
that the share which the buildings are on
when my son John now lives shall be his
after valuation tho the dwelling house & kitchen
not considered any part of valuation but the
barn be valued with the land

Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred & 37.
