with. I have bequeathed in the manner following
1st I will bequeath unto my beloved wife Katherine all
my Estate both real & personal & all my effects during
her lifetime or widowhood & after her decease my will
is that my lands shall be equally divided into 4th parts
of as near a equal value as can be done between my
children. That personal estate & negro property may
then belong to the estate to be put to sale to the highest
bidder by my executor & the proceeds to also be equally
divided amongst my children. And in carrying
should I die again my will is that on such an
occurrence that she should leave only 2nd part
of the said estate as the law provides for widows in
intestate estates & the distribution of the balance of the
Estate made as soon as practicable amongst my
children as above described then in case of her decease
for the faithful execution of this my last will & Testament
I do nominate ordain authorize & appoint My friend
Miles McHenry my Executor. In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this
11th day of June 1811 sealed signed & delivered
in the presence of us who was present at the signing
thereof & heard the said Testator acknowledge
to be his last will & Testament
