I Edwin Mullens of the County of Lincoln and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last Will & Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say, First that my Executors hereinafter named shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my Relations & friends & pay all funeral expenses together with my Just. debts howsoever & to whomsoever owing, out of the first item I give & devise to my beloved wife Barbara the tract of land on Live St. City a bound boy shall have Twelve months schooling to be paid out of my Estate, Then I also will and devise to my wife Barbara (after satisfying the above item) all the remainder of my property. And I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty friend Edward Dr. Ramsey & Barbara Mullens my lawful Executors to all intents & purposes to Execute this my last Will & Testament, according to the true intent & meaning of the same and every and every clause thereof, hereby revoking & declaring void all other Wills & Testaments by me heretofore made In Witness whereof I the said Edwin Mullens do hereunto set my hand & seal this 10th day of August A.D. 1861
