Secondly I will & bequeath unto my loving daughter Mary Hubbard one calf Thirdly I will also bequeath unto my loving daughter Hannah Robins two cows & one pair of dog brogs, fourthly I do hereby constitute ordain & appoint James Mackelroy, my lawful executor & I do hereby attorney disallow Proctor & diamond all & every other former P. testamente null, & vacuous & bequeath & execute by me in any wise before mentioned & bequeath no estate of mine & beginning this 4<sup>th</sup> day of November 1824.
