to wit. First I Commend my soul to God
almighty, Who gave it to me, and my body
I give to the Earth to be buried in a Christian
manner at the discretion of my Executor, hereafter

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named. And attaching my worldly Estate where
 it has pleased God to bless me in this life. I give
 and dispose in manner and form following
 First. I give & bequeath to my beloved friend & lady
 Houghton, Spinster Twenty five dollars, that is to say
 my term and tockings and all appertaining to the
 loom to be valued at eight dollars, and the balance
 in money to be paid out of my estate. Secondly. It
 is my will & desire that all the residue of my estate
 which will remain after the first Bequest is satisfied
 I give & bequeath to my sister Catherine Benfield
 to her only proper use during her natural life time
 & after her decease, whatever may remain of my
 property in her hands, it is my will & desire &
 I bequeath the same to Frederick Ireland to his
 own proper use & behalf forever. And I do
 hereby constitute my trusty friend John Smith, of
 Genesee County, my Executor of this my last will
 and testament, declaring this & no other to be
 my last will & testament. In testimony I have
