In the Name of God Amen
I, Francis J. Lehmon, of the County of Lincoln and State of North Carolina
being of sound mind & memory, and considering the uncertainty of
this frail and transitory life do therefore ordain publish & declare this to
be my last Will and testament, that is to say after all my lawful
debts are paid and discharged and a sufficient amount retained
out of my Estate for a decent burial and funeral expenses for my
body: That I will & bequeath to my son William Lehmon, three
hundred & fifty dollars to be discharged out of the first money coming
into the hands of my Executors I Will to my son William Lehmon
and my daughter Mary Coffin & my daughter Catharine Goodson
Equal portions of my Real and personal Estate, after paying by
my Executors out of my Estate to my Grand daughter Florence Lehmon
one hundred dollars \$100.
I desire I make known and appoint William Lehmon & George
Goodson to be Executors of this my last Will and testament, hereby
revoking all former Wills by me made, In testimony whereof I have here-
unto subscribed my name and affixed my seal this the fifth day
of February one thousand eight hundred & sixty six

of February one thousand eight hundred & sixty six
