 my surviving children and the surviving children of my said
 daughter Anne and I leave to have that part which their mother
 would be entitled to were she living to be equally divided between
 them, but here make I as mine my beloved wife, my my ex-
 and my two sons John and George executor of this my last will and
 Testament hereby blessing all former ones. I testify my
