of the County of Lincoln & State of Tennessee
Being of Sound & perfect mind & memory Blame
less to do this in the day of August in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
& twenty one. I publish this my last
will & testament in manner following that to wit
That I give & bequeath unto my wife Anne my negro boy
named Jeddah during her life & also I give unto
my wife Anne my wagon & full set of harness during
her life & also I give unto my wife Anne my horse
named Jack during her life & also I give unto
my wife Anne all my working tools & every kind
& all other implements for the use of my farm
during her life & also I give unto my wife Anne
my Wife's Dress & the Accompaniments to her belonging
during her life, & also I give unto my wife Anne
hens & calves her choice of my flock & sheep
hogs her choice for the pen & also I give her
choice of my flock as her own forever & also I
give unto my wife Anne, one hundred dollars
in money to be disposed of as she thinks proper
& also I give unto my wife Anne full power & privilege
of all my lands except the tract that my son William
DePue lives on & the tract that my son Merwin
DePue lives on & the tract which I purchased of Mr
McKee during her life & also I give unto my wife
Anne all my household & kitchen furniture during
her life & also I give unto my wife Anne all my stock
of provisions now on hand & all my crop growing
& gathered of every kind as her own forever

Jones to be my Son, my wife & co executor of my
last will & testament in witness whereof I the said
George Jones have to this my last will & testament
set my hand & seal the day & date above written

when they arrive at the age of twenty one years
I also give to my Son William ten dollars to
make his horse equal. I also give to my Son Alex
and Brown horse now claimed by them & one
horse to my son James which horse
claim as their own I also give to my wife Anne
one Bed & white spreaded Shear so. by purchase in
by my self full & testament I have given & hypothecate
to my wife Anne the sum of one hundred dollars

last will & testament in witness whereof I the said
George Jones have to this my last will & testament

one Brown Mare now claimed by him & one
Saddle horse to my son James which horses
claim as their own I also give to my wife Ann
one Red & white Spotted Shear so big & known in
by my self & full & testament which I have given & signed
as to my wife Ann this sum of one hundred dollars
to be paid under & declare that my will is

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The sum of fifty dollars to be paid unto her in full
of the said legacy I have as aforesaid given &
bequeathed unto her & that the remaining
part of the said legacy fall back into my estate
for distribution & whereas in my last will &
testament I have given & bequeathed to my wife
Ann a quantity of property to remain her during
her life. I do hereby order & declare that my will
is that the before mentioned property shall only
remain her during her life or widowhood

& lastly it is my desire that my present be will
be annexed to & made a part of my last will
& testament to all intents & purposes in all things
whereof I the said George Jones have herunto
set my hand & seal this day & year before written
