I George W. Monroe of the State of North Carolina  
of Lincoln County, Carolina & publish this my last  
Will & Testament. In the first place I will  
my soul to good w<sup>t</sup> who gave it & my body to the  
best from whence it came. It is my will  
& desire that my executors receive my Executing  
pay all my funeral charges & incidental  
expenses with all my just debts. in the second  
place I will and bequeath all my real & personal  
estate to my wife Eliza Holloman and my three  
children Elliott Holloman - Lucia Holloman &  
Elizah Holloman to be held in Common & share &  
share alike. It is further my will & desire that  
none of my property either real or personal be  
separated or sold unless for the payment of  
just debts or the education of my children. It  
is further my will & desire that my wife  
educate my children out of the proceeds  
of my real & personal estate of my Executing  
should find it necessary for the education  
of my children to sell & dispose of my real  
or personal estate she is authorized and  
empowered to do so. It is further my will  
& desire that my wife & executrix be empower-  
ed to sell and dispose of any of my real or  
personal estate if she should think it necessary  
for the benefit of herself & children. But  
in case of any change of circumstances  
so far to alter my executrix which would  
alter the right of any property either real  
& personal. It is my will also desired that  
my executrix shall have one fourth of all  
my real & personal property, absolute but  
the other three fourths to be equally divided
