I George W. Morrow of the State of North Carolina  
County Ordain & publish this my last  
Will & Testament. In the first place I will  
my soul to god who gave it & my body to the  
Christ from whence it came. It is my will  
& desire that my Executors be named Executors  
pay all my legal charges & debts of record  
together with all my just debts in the second  
place I will and bequeath all my real & personal  
estate to my wife Eliza Morrow and my three  
Children Robert H. Morrow - Edwin H. Morrow &  
Elijah G. Morrow to be held in common & share &  
share alike. It is further my will & desire that  
none of my property either real or personal be  
separated or sold unless for the payment of  
just debts or the education of my children. It  
is further my will & desire that my wife  
educate my children out of the proceeds  
of my real & personal estate if my Executors  
should find it necessary for the education  
of my children to sell & dispose of my real  
or personal estate she is authorized and  
empowered to do so. It is further my will  
& desire that my wife & Executors be empow-  
ered to sell and dispose of any of my real or  
personal estate & she should think it necessary  
for the benefit of herself & children. But  
in case of any change of circumstances  
in future with my Executors which would  
alter the right of any property either real  
or personal. It is my will & I desire that  
my Executors shall have one fourth of all  
my real & personal property a fourth by  
the other three fourths to be equally divided

to even her. I passed 1833  
of age. It is further my will  
that my executor, be appointed  
to my before named children  
I have no other all former will  
of my executor under my hand & seal  
of 8th day of September 1833

sum of money to be paid to him  
at the age of 21 years & if he  
dies before that time to be paid  
to his heirs & assigns forever.
