George P. Childers's Will.

State of North Carolina Lincoln County.

In the name of God Amen. I George P. Childers
being of Sound mind and memory to this the 22nd day
of July A.D. 1864. make publish and declare this my
last Will and Testament in manner and form following
(Viz)

Art. 1st. It is my will that all my just debts be paid.

Art 2nd. I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah
Childers all my real and personal Estate during her natural
lifetime or widowhood, and at the end of her lifetime or
widowhood the said property to be equally divided between
my two little sons Daniel W. and Wiley M. Childers.

Art. 3rd. I nominate and appoint my trust worthy friend
Joseph Starny Sen. Executor in this my last Will and
testament to be executed as above directed.
