manner & form first I allow all clothing to my  
grand daughter Hannah Bennett Except two bonnets  
frocks that I leave to my two grand daughters  
John Bennett two oldest daughters I will &  
bequeath unto my grand daughter Hannah Bennett  
my wheel & cards & my feather bed & half of  
the bed clothes furniture the balance to be  
John Bennett item I will that my funeral expenses  
and note for kitchen furniture be first paid & I will that my son William  
Bennet shall have my share of the land  
that Samuel Neely now lies on and for  
just and full execution of this my last  
will and testament I do nominate & appoint  
James Carroll my Executor signed &  
acknowledged day & date above mentioned  
James Montgomery Jurat *her.* *Barbara of Oldagon*
