of course be and remaining shall be divided in three
equal parts, the one third to my grandchildren books

& the one third to my step-daughter Barbara Wood
And I make and ordain my beloved son

John Executor of this my last Will & Testament. Two

I do give & bequeath unto my daughter Anna Howard
two children fifty five dollars & my side saddle
thirty dollars of the fifty five to be given to her son
William & twenty five to her daughter Elizabeth Manta
& the said side saddle.

I do give & bequeath unto my daughter Rachael
Lockman two children David & Rachael & Rachael
& Lockman each dollar each.
