

John Henry Wainwright's Will 207

In the name of God amen. I Henry Wainwright
of the County of Calaveras in the State of South
Carolina being of sound perfect mind & memory
(Blessed be God) do this last day of December
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
forty three make & publish this my last will &
testament in manner following. That is to say

At my decease all money or anything for gold or
any thing else on my lands is immediately to be
disposed of as soon as convenient the said lands
to be sold at public sale to the highest bidder
by the said bidder giving approved security for the
amount of said lands to be due in such time
as my executor shall think best. And the amount of
said lands & all my other property to be equally divided
amongst my lawful heirs with the exception of my
beloved wife Katherine which is not to receive any
thing of my estate as her own property, but she
is to be maintained out the said estate as long as
she lives. And I hereby make & ordain my worthy friend
David Wainwright Daniel Arentz executor of this
