I Henry Schuch being of sound mind & memory. (blessed be god) but weak & bodily strength. do this 17th day of December in the year of our Lord. Make & publish this my last will & Testament in manner & form following (that is to say)

I first give my soul to god from whence it came. Second I request that my body should be interred in a decent Christian burials manner.

3rd I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Schuch & my daughter Catharine Senora. all my Real & personal estate. to be equally divided between them at such time as they shall deem most expedient.

And I here by make & ordain my worthy friend. Peter Summey. Executor of this my last will & Testament.

In witness whereof I the said Henry Schuch have to this my last will & Testament set my hand this 17th day of December A.D. 1836
